Welsh history research tips & sites

Wales has a wealth of digital archive resources that are free to access online. You'll find newspapers, journals, images, texts, and studies across a number of websites hosted by academic institutions, local authorities, trusts and private organisations. If you are researching a Wales-related topic or project, this factsheet contains some research tips and a list of useful and trusted websites.

Bilingual searches

Wales is a bilingual country and the information you are searching for may be in one of the many Welsh-language publications. If you don't speak Welsh, compile a list of search terms and get them professionally translated (online translation tools are not yet sufficiently proficient and may lead to inaccurate search terms). If your search obtains results in Welsh-language publications, it's likely you'll need the services of professional translator to help you navigate the information available.



Spellings may differ

Spellings of names and place names sometimes differ between Welsh-language and English-language publications. The spellings may have also changed over time. Compile a list of the possible spellings before you start your research. You may need to ask for advice from your local archive.



Patronymics

If you're researching your family tree, it's likely that you'll come across Welsh patronymic names. This system describes family trees in terms of the male line only, giving a child the father's given name, or forename, as a surname. For example, Gwilym ap Dafydd translates as 'Gwilym, son of David'.



Deposits

If you're researching information about a topic in one county (e.g. Conwy), it doesn't necessarily mean that the archive information you're looking for is held in Conwy Archive. It's worth checking other county archives too. Use the 'Archives Wales' online search to help you identify the location of the information you require.
